



- One telephone number and/or "Inquire Within" or a similar phrase, and a room, apartment, or unit number if needed.

B. Political Campaign Signs

Signs announcing candidates seeking public office and other data pertinent thereto shall be permitted subject to the following regulations:

1. The maximum size allowed shall be nine (9) square feet in all residential zoning districts and thirty-two (32) square feet in all other districts.
2. No sign shall be located within or over the public right-of-way or located on utility poles.
3. No sign shall be located or erected on any property owned by the Town of Lady Lake, with the exception of campaign signs to be located at polling sites on election dates.
4. No sign shall be placed on a property until written permission from the owner of the property is provided to the Town.
5. No sign shall be erected prior to thirty (30) days before the first primary.
6. Candidates eliminated during any election, except the general election, shall remove signs within five (5) days following said election. After the general elections, all candidates shall remove signs within five (5) days.
7. A one hundred dollar (\$100.00) cash bond or campaign check shall be posted with the Town prior to erecting any sign to ensure placement of signs in acceptable locations and removal of all signs within five (5) days following the election as provided above.
8. The Town may remove and destroy any sign erected for which a bond or campaign check has not been posted, or any sign that is remaining five (5) days following an election in violation of subsection 5) above. If all of the signs are removed, the deposit will be refunded. The cash bond or campaign check will be forfeited if any signs remain more than five (5) days after the election or if any sign is placed without an owner's consent or as otherwise not allowed per this Code.

C. Open House Signs

In all zoning districts, two (2) on-premises signs not to exceed twelve (12) square feet in area each, inviting the inspection of property may be placed in addition to a permitted for sale or lease sign. Said sign shall be limited to the words "OPEN" or "OPEN HOUSE" or similar words. All signs shall be removed daily at the end of the open house.
