### Suspect Arrested in Spanish Springs Bomb Threat

**Charge:** False Report of Planting a Bomb



**Synopsis:** On December 1, 2013 at approximately 2:05pm Anthony Nason Borrell called the Gators Dockside Restaurant in Spanish Springs and informed the manager that he had placed a bomb in the restaurant. The restaurant was evacuated and a bomb detection dog was called in to search the building. No bomb was found and the restaurant reopened for business. Investigators learned that Borrell placed the call from a pay phone near his home in Ocoee, FL in an attempt to get his female friend, a waitress at the restaurant, out of work for the day. After speaking with detectives, Borrell turned himself in at the Lady Lake Police Department on December 5, 2013. He was booked into the Lake County Jail with a bond of \$4,000.
