

DESCRIPTION: On January 9, 2014, a vicious robbery occurred in the shopping center parking lot at the intersection of U.S. Hwy 27/441 and Rolling Acres Rd. As the subject and the victim struggled over the victim's purse, the victim was violently shoved to the ground resulting in serious injuries and required long-term rehabilitation. Since that date, Lady Lake detectives have been working diligently to identify and apprehend the perpetrators.

After an exhaustive three month, multi-jurisdiction investigation, Lady Lake detectives have identified multiple suspects involved in this, and similar purse snatching incidents in other Florida counties. Armed with information obtained by Lady Lake detectives, arrests have also been made by Polk and Orange County deputies for crimes occurring in those jurisdictions.

On April 6, 2014, Latoyia Inmon, the identified getaway driver in the Lady Lake robbery was arrested in Seminole County on a Lady Lake Warrant for the January incident. She is currently being held on a \$20,000 bond. The primary assailant in this crime has been identified as Deaundre D. Green, a 17 year old juvenile from Orlando with an extensive criminal history. Lady Lake detectives have applied for an arrest warrant and intend to charge him as an adult.
