### RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

May 21, 2016

On May 20, 2016 at approximately 7:11AM Lady Lake Police Officers responded to a golf cart that was partially submerged in a pond off of Silver Oak Avenue. While searching for the golf cart's owner, the officers discovered that the home at 860 Silver Oak Avenue had been broken into. The house backs up to the pond area and golf cart tracks were observed entering the front yard and sliding down the steep hill into the pond. The newly constructed home was unoccupied and the owners were out of town.

After Kling Towing pulled the golf cart from the pond, detectives were able to identify its owner, Michael Hawk, of 1310 Debra Drive. Officers located Michael Hawk at his residence where they also located his wet clothing along with the stolen television and a set of keys belonging to the homeowners at 860 Silver Oak Avenue.

Hawk was placed under arrest and charged with Burglary of an Unoccupied Residence and Grand Theft. He was booked into the Lake County Jail with a bond of \$7,000.
